

UPDATE: MASK POLICY AND COMMUNION

The Executive Committee, as well as the Leadership Council, has been monitoring the most recent information concerning the Covid-19 delta variant. The federal Centers for Disease Control has identified Pima County as "an area of substantial or high transmission" based on Pima County Health Department data provided to them.

The latest CDC guidelines recommend that all people, whether fully vaccinated or not, **wear a mask in indoor public spaces**. In light of this information, Desert Hope will follow the CDC guidelines.

We will also temporarily suspend serving Communion individually at the front of the church and return to using the prepackaged Communion sets from our seats. No other changes will be instituted at this time. Keep us in your prayers as we seek to do what is best for our congregation.

HOLY COMMUNION:

Holy Communion is for those who trust in Jesus and believe He brings the grace He promises in this Holy Meal. We are grateful that we have found a way to safely have communion together in-person and online.

For in-person worship we are using prepackaged communion kits that contain a wafer and grape juice sealed in a cup. You will pick up the kit from the large table in the Narthex immediately after you sanitize your hands when you arrive. Following the Words of Institution and the Lord's Prayer, you will lift your mask away from your mouth; and we will all take communion together while everyone stays in their seats. Afterwards, please replace your mask over your nose and mouth. The ushers will come by to pick up the used cups and sanitize your hands. If you are worshipping at home, gather wine or grape juice and bread and take communion during the same time.
