

CHANGES COMING TO LEADERSHIP COUNCIL IN FEBRUARY

Changes are coming to the Leadership Council in 2023. To help you better understand the reasoning behind the change requires looking back to the end of 2021 and early 2022.

During Desert Hope's history, our governance model evolved to a point where the majority of administrative responsibility and authority fell to three positions in the church: the Pastor, the Church Administrator, and the Leadership Council President. Late in 2021 we lost our Pastor and our Church Administrator, and with those losses our mission and ministries were seriously impacted. This revealed that our governance model was not serving our current or future needs.

In early 2022, the Leadership Council reached out to the LCMC National Office for help. Pastor Perry Fruhling, Coordinator for Pastoral Ministry, recommended we bring in an Intentional Interim Pastor to help us through our transition. This Pastor would have three responsibilities:

- 1. Help us deal with the loss of two pastors in two years.
- 2. Help us find and implement a better church governance model.
- 3. Help us identify the qualities needed in our next called pastor.

Leadership Council formed a Church Governance Team to investigate various church governance models and make recommendations on the best model for our congregation. The team, chaired by Terry Bredehoft, was made up of former leadership council presidents and officers.

Pastor Kent Groethe was hired as the Intentional Interim Pastor in August. Since that time, he has been evaluating our current governance model. In conjunction with the Leadership Council and the Governance Team, he believes the size of the present council, which at its peak had 14 members, is too large.

In alignment with our present constitution and bylaws, which requires a minimum of seven members plus the Lead Pastor and Treasurer, the Council agreed to decrease the size of the Leadership Council through natural attrition. Six council members' terms end in February. Three of those positions will not be filled. Three council members, Dan Knauss, Judy Martin and Patti Thibaut, have each agreed to serve another two-year term. They will be joined on the ballot by Terry Bredehoft. He brings his gift of administration and knowledge of the Governance Team findings to the Leadership Council. He will help facilitate Desert Hope's transition to a new governance mode.
