3dm & Huddle Group Information

In 2009 I got an email from "Alpha" program about a new ministry called "3dm". I kept that email in my in-box for about 6 months before I did anything about it. It was an invitation to a 3dm "taster". At the last minute I signed up to go. It was an immersion experience in a small group model of accountable discipleship. I was introduced to the concept of "Kairos moments" and the "two questions": "What is God saying to you? What are you going to do?"

The concept of "Kairos moments" transformed my understanding and experience of God speaking to me through the circumstances of the day, the Scriptures, and people I met in my dayto-day life. Kairos moments are times in which God breaks into our world to guide us, inspire us and lead us to people to be led to Jesus Christ. I found that the two questions when asked and answered again and again within a small group moves the people of the group forward in life and faith. These two questions enliven the accountability group experience. Huddle groups are a dynamic search for God in each and every day, even moment of our lives. The weekly times we gather together will be times of excitement and growth seeing what God is doing in our personal lives, the life of the huddle, and our church.

The commitment for this group is for one year minus holidays and vacations. Once people have indicated interest, we will pick a time that meets the needs of most that can attend. We will not be meeting Saturday or Sunday or in the evenings. Late in the afternoon is a possibility. We will be using two books for study material "Empowering Missional Disciples" by Rev. Bob Rognlien (Lutheran pastor) and "Building a Discipling Culture". We will start the first week of February.
